Rally was great from the day we started serving, Aug 5. We served 671 people pancakes in 8 days. We also served 70 gallons of coffee and 64 gallons of orange juice.

We had to cancel our last day due to a kidney stone that sent Brenda to the ER on Saturday night (Aug 6). We got back at 1:30 in the morning and then had to get up at 4:30 to start the day serving pancakes again.

We were scheduled to preach in Kansas on Sunday, Aug 14th on our way home and wasn't sure if she would be able to stand the 10 1/2 hour drive all in one day. We drove the distance over 2 days and it turned out that

was a wise decision. She actually passed the stone about 2 hours east of Sturgis, in Kadoka, SD on our way to Kansas.

Some of the people we were able to minister to included: Gene from Idaho who we met 3 years ago and we were able to pray with this year, a Mormon man who we talked with and was excited to receive one of the many LFTL bibles we handed out, and also a pimp and his 3 Lakota "girls" who came in. We were able to feed them and show them the love of Jesus by being servants.

We started the day with the usual "free pancake" breakfast and changed up lunch this year because of our new outreach cook trailer.



We served pork steaks to 486 people and made 11 gallons of baked beans in the cast iron jambalaya pot! The pork steaks were marinated and seasoned by a guy from the First A/G church in Iberia, MO. They were awesome and everyone enjoyed them. The steaks actually opened their hearts up for ministry of which many received.
